All bookings are subject to a £10 deposit per player. Bookings are only confirmed once a deposit is received by written confirmation is received from the club. Final numbers must be confirmed 48 hours prior to your event, failure to do so will incur loss of the deposit for the players who do not attend; additional charges may be waived at the discretion of the golf club.

Balance of payments must be made on the day of the event prior to teeing off; this can be done by cash, cheque or card. Cheques payable to West Essex Golf Club Limited.

It is the responsibility of the organiser to ensure that his party behaves appropriately, has the correct standard of dress as per the dress code below and adheres to the tee times booked.

All players are advised to carry insurance cover for the protection of themselves and others. The golf club cannot accept any responsibility for articles lost or stolen.

Play must be from the yellow or red tees. Slow play should be avoided at all times.

Players are requested to replace all divots and repair all pitch marks. Buggies and trolleys should not be taken onto greens, tees or through bunkers. Bunkers should be raked after playing.

The organiser accepts responsibility for any damage caused by any members of his party.

The use of sponsorship signs or other advertising material is only allowed by the authorisation of the General Manager

Dress Code

Players should wear golf shoes, sleeved shirts with a collar or polo neck. Purpose made collarless golf shirts are allowed. Shirts must be tucked in unless designed to be worn outside. Tailored shorts may be worn with white socks of any length. Tailored trousers may be worn with any colour of socks.

Tracksuits, cargo shorts, cargo trousers, flip flops and ripped jeans are not permitted on the golf course or in the Club House. Smart jeans are permitted only in the club house.

Golf shoes are not permitted in the bar.
